









# Working with cleaning products

# General guidelines:

- Use only products that are in their original packaging.
- Use only products with a readable label.
- Always follow the safety guidelines on the product label..
- Never mix different products yourself.
- Always use the correct dose of products to dilute in water.
- Ask the customer for gloves and wear them when using cleaning products.
- Ask the client to preferably **purchase products in liquid form** and limit the purchase of sprays. Aerosols can irritate the lungs or cause asthma.
- If you must use sprays, do not spray the products on the surface, but apply them to a cloth to use.
- For dusting, do not use products; prefer to use a microfibre cloth.
- If possible, **open a window** where you clean, or ask for the **ventilation system** to be switched on. This refreshes the air and dilutes the fumes from the products.
- Wear work clothes to avoid any contact of the product with the skin.
- Ask customers to wash cloths and mops weekly.

## Products with these symbols may be used, but strictly follow the instructions on the label:

- Products without warning symbols on the label.
- Products with the **following symbols**:



These products may be irritating or may have minor harmful effects.

Always read the label carefully and apply the conditions of use indicated on it.



These products are flammable and may catch fire when in contact with a flame or heat source.



These products are especially dangerous for the environment. So don't pour them down a sink or sewer.

# These products may not be used:

Products with the **following symbols**:



GHS03

Oxidising products contain a lot of oxygen and therefore strongly promote the ignition of flammable or combustible substances.



GHS08

These products are cancercausing, mutagenic or harmful to fertility.



GHS06

These products are toxic.



GHS05

These products are corrosive and can cause skin burns. Proper gloves are needed to work with these safely.



Explosive products can explode due to a flame, heat, shock or friction.



#### • Products with the following risk phrases:

- o H314 Causes severe burns and eye damage.
- o H317 May cause allergic skin reaction.
- o H318 Causes serious eye damage.
- o H336 May cause sleepiness or dizziness.
- EUH208 Contains < name of sensitising substance >. May cause an allergic reaction.

#### Specific products:

- o Ammonia
- o Javel
- o White Spirit
- o Hydrochloric acid and other corrosive products
- o Toilet unblocker
- o Acetone or washing alcohol
- o Ether and other industrial products
- o Home-made products (customer-made mixtures)

## In case of emergency - First aid

- **Product on skin or in eyes**: rinse with plenty of water.
- If swallowed: drink plenty of water (do not vomit).
