### 1. A warm welcome and a good start

A friendly welcome and a clear introduction ensure a safe and pleasant work environment.

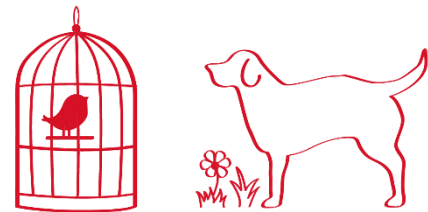
### 2. Clear agreements and information

Through open and transparent communication about rules and expectations, your household helper can work safely.



### Keep pets at a distance:

To allow the work to run smoothly, it is required to keep pets away during working hours. This contributes to the safety and comfort of both your household helper and your pet.



### A tidy home:

A clean and organized house reduces the risk of tripping or falling, which significantly increases your household helper's safety. It also enables more efficient and ergonomic work.



### Good instructions save lives:

A well-informed household helper works not only more efficiently but also more safely.

### Proper use of devices and products:

For the safety of your household helper and to protect your home, it's important to give clear instructions on how to use appliances and cleaning products. **Please note:** ammonia and bleach must not be used.

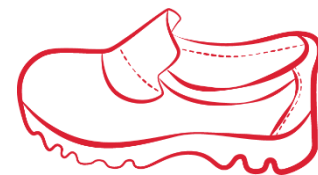
### Ergonomics and safety at the workplace:

To prevent overexertion and accidents, please ensure your household helper does not have to carry heavy items up or down the stairs. If possible, provide cleaning supplies on each floor.



### 3. Safety shoes are mandatory

Your household helper wears safety shoes for their own protection. Please do not ask them to remove these, as wearing them is **legally required**.
